## MINUTE RECORD VILLAGE OF FIRTH REGULAR MEETING

August 4, 2020

The maintenance report was given. It was noted that the new mower/shredder will be delivered this week. Dave Hansmeyer gave an update on Selenium levels in the large well. The numbers continue to go down.

The Board discussed potential locations for a new well. It was agreed that the park would be a good place since it is proven there is good water in that location. It was agreed that Dave Hobelman and Dave Hansmeyer would hold a conference call with Justin Stark from Olsson to further discuss next steps for a new well location.

The Board discussed a bid from Scott Prange for scraping the edges of the street and street-side of the ditch for two blocks of Everett and Allen Streets. It was agreed to focus on just Everett Street and the Board Chair will ask Mr. Prange for a new bid to reflect this.

There have been two requests for soccer goals for the green space behind the small ball field. It was agreed that Dave Hansmeyer would weld goal frames that can be easily moved for mowing purposes. The goals will be made in the next couple weeks.

It was moved by Amanda Eisenhauer, seconded by Craig Middle, to approve paying Olsson Associates \$1,800 for additional park

survey work. This will help with the ADA park sidewalk plan. Roll call vote: 5 Yeas, no Nays. Motion carried.

It was moved by Jason Cooper, seconded by Brian Flood to approve Resolution #2020-08-1 adopting the Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan created by the Lower Platte South NRD along with JEO Consulting. Roll call vote: 5 Yeas, no Nays. Motion carried.

The Board discussed future options for recycling in Firth. It was agreed to ask Seth Harms from Capital City Refuse to attend a meeting for further discussion on what options they can offer.
