Firth Comprehensive Plan update

The Village has contracted with Olsson Associates and Five Rule Planning to update the 2008 comprehensive plan. Firth looks much different than it did in 2008, especially with the North Ridge housing development, and the needs of the village have changed. The comprehensive plan is a valuable tool in helping a municipality manage growth in a way that benefits the community and makes it stronger. Public input has been gathered and stakeholder interviews have been conducted. The consultants are currently working on the housing component of the comprehensive plan. The updated comprehensive plan will be ready for approval in the spring 2019.
